2018 – 2019 Scholarship

The Grandwood Park Civic Association will be awarding two (2) scholarships of \$500.00 to Grandwood Park / The Shire residents in 2019. The board is proud to be able to bring back this program to help support and invest in the youth of our community.

Application packets will be available online at grandwoodpark.net or by contacting the Civic Association at civicasociation@grandwoodpark.net. All applications must be received via email or postmarked by Friday, June 14, 2019.

See the application for complete details. Failure to meet all eligibility requirements will result in loss of points or disqualification.

Applicant Requirements Include:

1. Must be enrolled in or accepted by a state accredited college, university or technical/trade school and planning to attend as a full-time student in the fall semester 2019.
2. Must have a history of community involvement and service over the past two years.
3. Must be in good standing with their current school and have passing grades.
4. Must have a personal interview. Interviews are tentatively scheduled for June 2019.
5. Must have completed scholarship application package, post marked no later than May 17, 2019 including:
 - a. An original essay describing their career hopes and aspirations (a minimum of 250 words)
 - b. A minimum of two personal character references.
 - c. The Affidavit of Eligibility Form
 - d. A current transcript of grades showing GPA
 - e. Membership must be current at Grandwood Park Civic Association
 - f. Previous recipients and previous applicants may re-apply, though you are limited to no more than two awards.

The scholarships will be awarded based upon the application, essay, interview, and scoring requirements. All applicants will be notified of the results no later than June 30th, 2019.
