

Board of Commissioners / Special Session Minutes

Governor Pritzker signed P.A. 100-0640 (SB 2135) into law on Friday June 12, 2020, allowing public bodies the use of virtual meetings during a declared disaster without violating the Open Meetings Act. 
3. Discussion:
